

GUIDELINES FOR BRINGING CHILDREN TO CLASSES

We have set out a few guidelines below that will help to keep people and dogs in your class safe and comfortable.

Please ensure that:

- 1. Your children remain with you in the area that has been allocated to you and your dog.
- 2. Children are not allowed to roam, run or walk around the hall before, during or after a class.
- 3. Only one child at a time is permitted to work with the adult to prevent confusion for your dog.
- 4. Your children should not interfere with another dog in the class or outside in the car park.
- 5. We recommend that the adult teaches the exercise to the dog first to ensure the dog understands the behaviour. You can then teach your child to complete the exercise with your dog.
- 6. Dig it Dogs take no responsibility for any accidents or injuries that occur as a result of you bringing your child to class.
